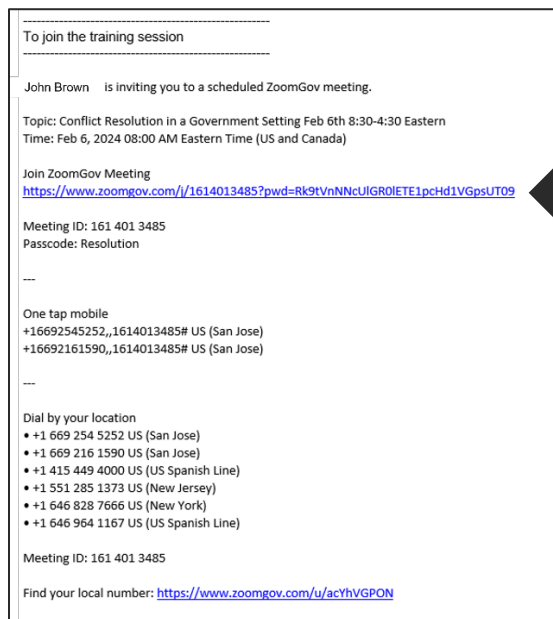
How to access meetings in Zoom for Government

Who has access?

Some classes offered at DFAS may use the Zoom for Government platform. As a DFAS employee, you have access on your government issued laptops using a **web browser only**. Once you receive class information from the course facilitator or instructor, you will follow these instructions.

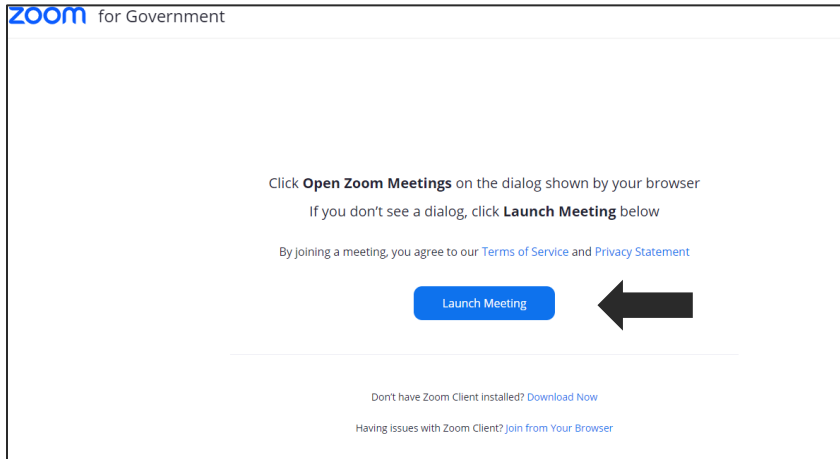
Message

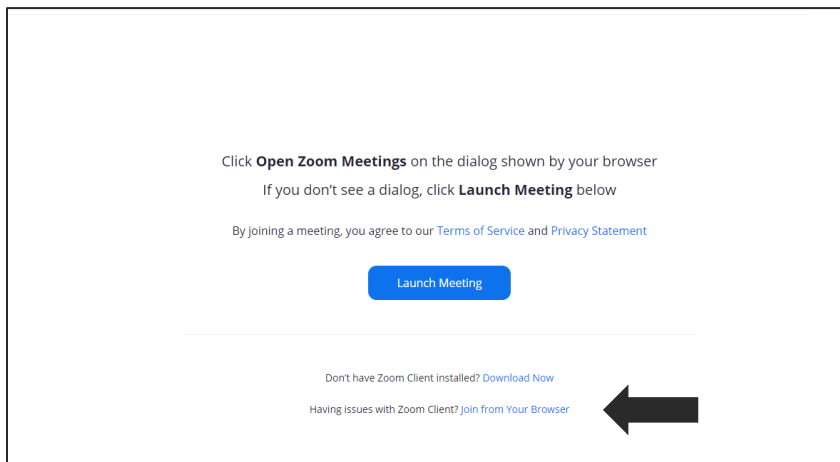


Select the link or copy and paste it in a browser.
(If you have difficulty connecting, choose another browser and try again.)

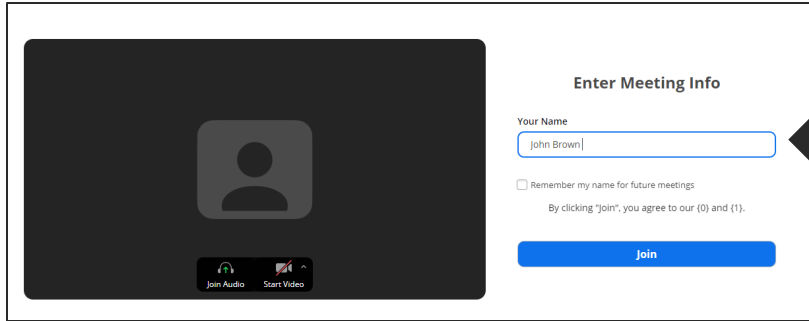
Joining the Class/Meeting



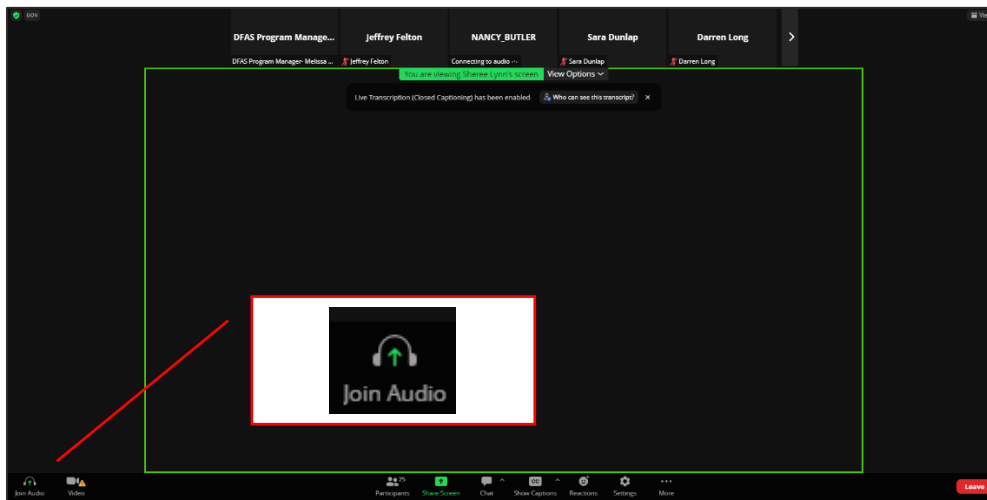
Select **Launch Meeting**



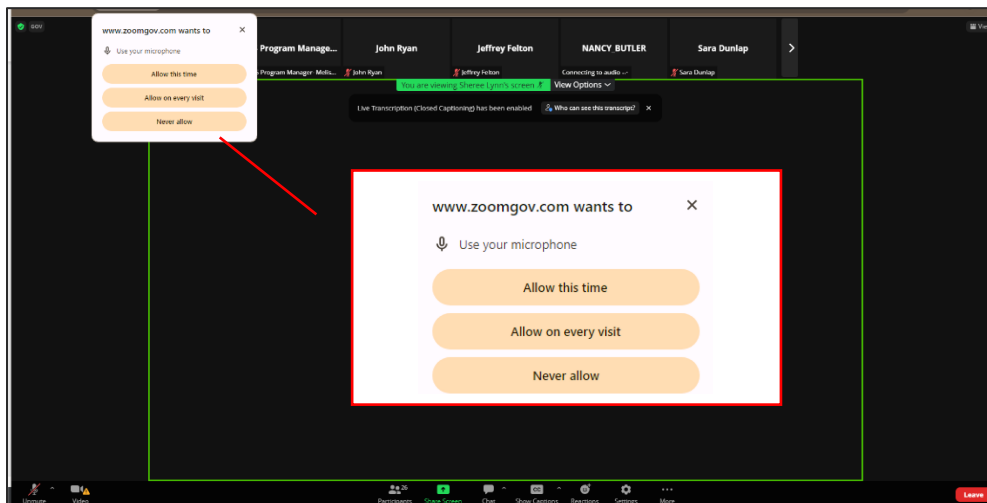
Then, select **Join from Your Browser**



Type your **First and Last Name**



Select **Join Audio**
(lower left of the screen)



Give Zoomgov permission to use your microphone.
